At Rabbit Hill farm, we make every effort to take the best possible care of your dog. However, you should be aware that while boarding, your dog may:

- Experience stress (due to separation anxiety or an unfamiliar environment, for example) or “kennel boredom,” which may cause the dog to chew itself, or to pull its hair out.
- Develop a medical problem, or have a flare up of a recurring medical problem.

If, in our opinion, your dog needs medical attention, we will make every effort to contact you before taking any action. However, if we deem it a medical emergency, or if we are unable to contact you, we will take the dog to the veterinarian. We will try to use your regular vet. However, if that vet is unavailable, we will use another vet. BY INITIALING THIS PARAGRAPH, YOU AGREE TO ALLOW US TO TAKE YOUR DOG TO THE VET, AS WE DEEM NECESSARY, AND TO PAY THOSE CHARGES, WITHOUT HOLDING RABBIT HILL FARM LIABLE. \_\_\_\_\_[client's initials].

Dogs that routinely come when called may be permitted to run on the farm (outside a confined kennel area). We make every effort to maintain the chain link fence that surrounds our 20-acre farm. However, if you know, or suspect, that your dog can jump a 4 foot fence, dig or squeeze under a fence or under our front gate, or is otherwise “an escape artist,” you have a responsibility to let us know. Under no circumstances will such a dog be allowed to run on the farm. If your dog does come when called and is not an escape artist, but you still do not want your dog to run on the farm, it is also your responsibility to let us know.
